49% of dogs are frightened of loud noises.

Tips to help your pet this firework season.

- **Let them hide** Provide comfortable, safe hiding places or dens around the home that pets can go to if they're feeling scared.
- **Keep them inside** Make sure cat flaps, doors and windows are closed. Pets are more easily stressed if they're outside during fireworks.
- **Daytime walks** Avoid times when fireworks are likely to be set off.
- **Reduce noise** Close curtains and mask the noise of fireworks by playing music or having the TV on.
- **Keep calm** Keeping your behaviour normal and relaxed will help your pet stay as calm as possible.
- **Don't leave them alone** Having familiar faces around will help them feel more relaxed.
